The Kennedy family, Colleen, Theresa, Jessica, and Adler, has collected seeds nearly every week as well. We'll add all these seeds to others and spread more than 60 species over 13 acres of two recently-harvested soybean fields on November 10<sup>th</sup>. We'll be planting several other areas in the Park as well.
