INFORMATION ABOUT THE LPF

LPF formed in 1989 as a nonprofit organization. The first project was to raise funds and enlist volunteers dedicated to lighting the 2.5 mile ski trail. Here are a few other projects LPF has supported or are currently supporting:

- Developed Disabled Accessible Trail
- Funded at Trecker Lodge - fireplace, furniture, rubber flooring, trail lights down to the shelter and windmill
- Funded animal mounts
- Partially funded to paint buildings near the Evergreen Shelter
- Built kiosks around the park
- Provided some grooming equipment
- At Evergreen Shelter area provided water source, stove furniture and currently a covered open picnic shelter
- Fundraising for snowmaking project
